

ZETA JOURNAL/SCRAPBOOK

The 2010 Zeta Journal/Scrapbook submission requirements are as follows:

- All Zeta Journal/Scrapbook must have chapter name, chapter size auxiliary information, current membership roster for identification and state. **This information should be place on the inside front cover.**
- All Zeta Journals/Scrapbook must outline the National Observances and programs of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Incorporated inclusive of, but not limited to the programmatic thrust, Z-HOPE.
- Pictures of documentation must accompany events outlined in the journal/scrapbook. Pictures must be labeled with a description of the event that is captured in the photo.
- Letters of documentation must accompany events outlined in the journal/scrapbook. **Letters from previous years may not be entered.**
- Chapter's will be evaluated on organization; grammar; originality; creativity; **Zeta Principles:** Scholarship, Service, Sisterly Love, **National Program:** Z-HOPE; Stork's Nest; March of Dimes; **National Observances:** Finer womanhood; Founder's Day, **Conferences:** Boule; ZOL; Regional; State; Sponsored membership: Auxiliaries, Youth, Undergrad: Campus Activity, Awards/Honor and Greek Unity.

JUDGING CRITERIA

To insure equity and fairness, journal/scrapbook will be judged based on chapter size as follows:

Graduate:	Under 25 members; 25+ members
Undergraduate:	Under 10; 10+ members
Amicae/Youth:	Under 10+ members; 0 members

Each state is encouraged to assign two (2) Sorors, one graduate and one undergraduate to sit on the Zeta Journal/Scrapbook Committee. To maintain fairness, only two (2) Sorors, per state will be allowed to participate in the evaluation process. The Committee Chair does not hold a vote for judging the Journals/Scrapbook.

AWARDS

Each first place graduate, undergraduate and auxiliary chapter will be listed on the chronicle award plaque. In addition they will receive a certificate of recognition.
